<p>Arrival & Dismissal Procedures:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Cars must have a student tag to come into the parent loop at arrival and dismissal. Parents are not to get out of their cars.• Parent walkers will stay behind the designated markers for drop off and pick up.• One student per seat on the bus. Masks are required. Social distance required on the bus stops.	<p>Face Covering:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Masks are required for everyone on BCPS property or in a vehicle. Masks are required during transportation to/from school on a bus as well as outside.• No gators or bandanas.• We ask each student to bring an extra mask.
<p>Screening & Stay Home When Appropriate:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Signed screening forms will be sent home• If you don't feel well, stay home.• If students experience symptoms, they will be placed in a separate room and the family will be called for pickup.	<p>Social Distancing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Classroom furniture is arranged to provide 6-foot separation between students, when possible.• Grade levels must only use their assigned stairway• Student will use lockers, grouped by 6-ft intervals and identified accordingly, for coats and lunches.• Recess- students are not allowed on the playgrounds. Students must wear a mask during recess. Socially-distanced games are permitted• Social distancing will be required while on school grounds
<p>Hand Hygiene:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Each classroom will be equipped with soap and paper towel dispensers.• Several free-standing handwashing stations have been placed strategically around the building.• Times for handwashing or use of hand sanitizer will be scheduled and handwashing lessons conducted.	<p>Breakfast & Lunch:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Breakfast and lunch will be provided free of charge each day• No money will be exchanged. No snacks available.• Students will have lunch in the cafeteria or other designated areas and will be spaced accordingly facing in one direction.
<p>Supplies & Devices:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students will not share items. They will carry their backpacks with them to specials with their own materials and supplies provided by VVES.• Students must bring their device, charger, and headphones back and forth to school.• Students must have their transportation tag each day.	<p>Visitors:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• To visit a BCPS school, visitors must have an appointment.• Visits will be conducted remotely or outside, whenever possible.• If an indoor visit is required, visitors will be required to wear a face coverings and practice social distancing.• The number of people admitted to the building will be limited.
